Bachelor in Administration (BSc)

A globally focused undergraduate program that blends management, innovation, and public policy with real-world impact. Master in Management (MiM)

English (both BSc & MiM). Students may also take courses taught in Portuguese upon presenting a valid Portuguese proficiency certificate.

BSc: 6–8 courses/semester (4 ECTS each)
MiM: 2–4 courses/term (5 ECTS each)

Course Flexibility

Students can take up to **two courses from other FGV schools**, such as Law, Economics, and Communication

Transcript of Records

Sent by email approximately **one month after the end of the academic term.**

Mandatory Documents

Passport, student visa (VITEM IV), CPF, health insurance (min. €30,000 or \$42,000), official transcript, ID photo (3x4)

Important Email Guidance

We highly recommend using a **Gmail address** when starting your application. University email accounts often mistakenly filter our messages as spam, leading to missed information and communication issues.

Language Requirements

No English test is required; however, we recommend students have at least a B2 level of proficiency.

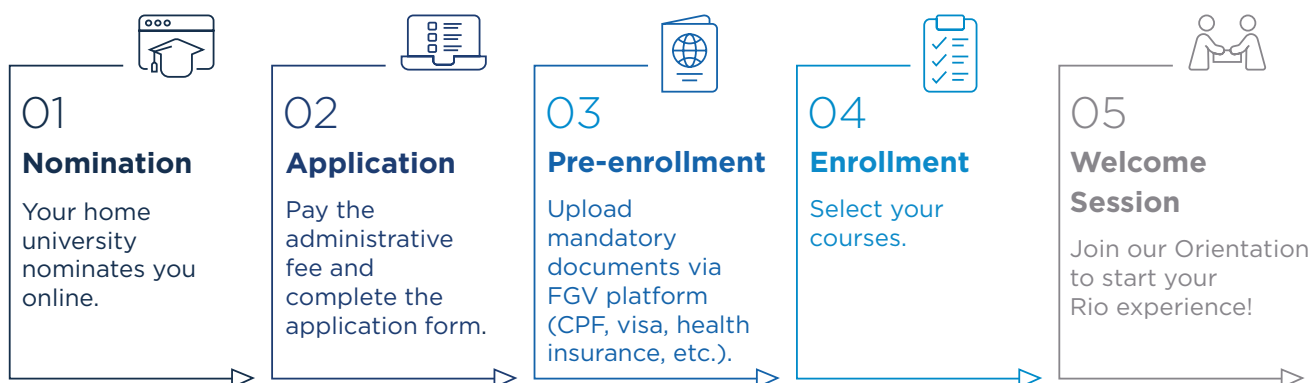

Additional Key Info:

- **Visa:** Student visa (VITEM IV) required for stays over 90 days.
- **CPF:** Essential for enrollment; get it as early as possible.
- **Health Insurance:** Coverage of at least €30,000 or \$42,000 is mandatory.
- **Accommodation:** Secure your spot right after nomination.
