A successful project depends on proper analysis and planning in the early and key phase of project initiation. This <u>two-day module</u> will provide an overview of the process to develop the initial scope and high-level requirements for a project. Participants will learn strategic options analysis techniques, costing and schedule estimation, strategic procurement strategies, and the risks inherent in various strategies. The module will also identify important stakeholder engagement strategies. Industry participants will gain an understanding and perspective of how to interact effectively with the government approval processes and policies.

- How to identify an affordable scope with the appropriate budget estimate.
- How and when to engage key stakeholders.
