SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS

Eligibility criteria

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Be a Canadian citizen, a permanent resident, a person with protected or refugee status, or an international student.
- Be enrolled as a student in the PhD in Management program at the Telfer School of Management of the University of Ottawa.
- Demonstrate academic excellence.
- Have successfully completed a thesis proposal defence.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- a letter (max. 500 words) describing how the applicant's thesis will affect research on management (including but not limited to, the economic, social and environmental impact). The applicant must also explain why this research is expected to be significant.

- an academic curriculum vitae
- unofficial transcripts for PhD courses
